Job Description

The Fuel Attendant (or Gas Jockey) is required to provide full-service customer service to all fuel customers as well as greeting and assisting all non-fuel customers who enter the premises. This includes the servicing of vehicles, such as dispensing gasoline, diesel, or propane; checking and filling fluids; washing windshields. The fuel attendant is also responsible for ensuring the store area is clean and presentable, and fully stocked with merchandise, as well as site and property maintenance and upkeep.

Key Responsibilities of the Role

A Gas Jockey is required to complete the following duties and responsibilities, obtain, and maintain the required certifications, and assist in store operations, including but not limited to:

Customer Service – Greet and assist all patrons, provide a positive experience for all. Provide "Full-Service" – Dispense fuel and propane, check and fill fluids, clean windshields, etc. Cash Management – complete transactions on various POS systems, provide change, cash cheques, process electronic payments, complete Purchase Orders, etc. Inventory Management – stocking product, checking expiry dates, ordering, and receiving, blocking, and facing, conduct regular inventory counts, etc. Site Maintenance – Complete custodial duties, such as sweeping, mopping, dusting, cleaning bathrooms, beverage dispensers, counters, windows, car wash, etc. Store Merchandising – Ensure the Jockey Supply Cart is stocked with automotive fluids required to efficiently provide full-service experience to customers. Block and Face products. Health & Safety – Attend regular H&S meetings, maintain necessary certifications, etc. Teamwork – Attend regular Staff meetings, cooperate with co-workers.
